Day 01: Mattala Airport - Yala

Arrival at Mattala International Airport.

Transfer to Yala and check-in at the hotel.

Evening jeep safari in Yala National Park, where



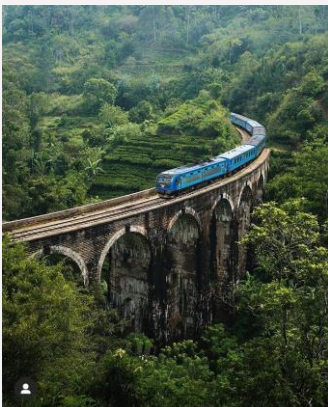
you may spot elephants, leopards, sloth bears, spotted deer, wild boars, and sambars.

Smaller mammals include black-naped hare, various mongoose species, civets, and porcupines.

The park is also a birdwatcher's paradise with over 140 species, including the crested serpent eagle, Malabar pied hornbill, jungle fowl, painted stork, white ibis, and black stork.

Dinner and overnight stay in Yala

Day 02: Yalla - Ella -Nuwara Eliya



Breakfast at the hotel.

Transfer to Ella, a charming hillside village with breathtaking views.

Explore tea plantations, temples, and waterfalls.

Enjoy a starry night with views of distant lighthouses.

Visit the iconic Nine Arches Bridge.

Transfer to Nuwara Eliya, a cool-climate town reminiscent of British colonial charm.

Discover colonial bungalows, hedgerows, and one of the world's finest 18-hole golf courses.

Drive through lush valleys dotted with waterfalls and tea pickers in colorful saris.

Dinner and overnight stay in Nuwara Eliya.

Day 03: Nuwara Eliya - Kandy



Breakfast at the hotel.

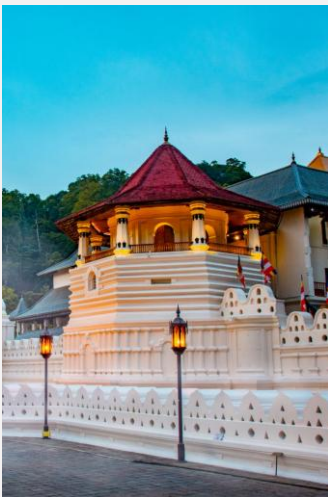
Transfer to Kandy via Ramboda Falls.

Visit the Royal Botanical Gardens in Peradeniya, one of Asia's finest.

Explore themed zones of tropical flora, a collection of 750 indoor plant species, 100 orchid varieties, and 175 types of palms.

Dinner and overnight stay in Kandy.

Day 04: Kandy City Tour



Breakfast at the hotel.

Sightseeing in Kandy, the last royal capital of Sri Lanka.

Visit the artificial lake, Udawatta Kele forest, and the Royal Summer Palace.

Explore the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic (Dalada Maligawa), gemstone museum, and local markets.

Dinner and overnight stay in Kandy.

Day 05: Kandy - Dambulla



Breakfast at the hotel.

Transfer to Dambulla via Matale.

Visit the Spice Garden in Matale to see cinnamon, cloves, pepper, vanilla, cardamom, and more.

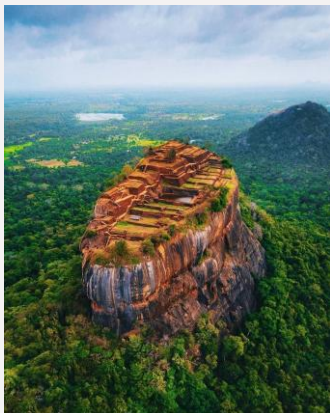
Learn about their culinary, medicinal, and cosmetic uses.

Visit the UNESCO-listed Golden Cave Temple in Dambulla, built into a 150-meter rock.

Explore five caves with over 2,000-year-old Buddha statues and stunning frescoes.

Dinner and overnight stay in Dambulla.

Day 06: Dambulla - Sigiriya



Breakfast at the hotel.

Climb Sigiriya Rock Fortress, one of Sri Lanka's most iconic landmarks.

Discover palace ruins, gardens, pools, and ancient frescoes.

Enjoy a village tour by tractor or cart, river safari, and sample traditional Sri Lankan cuisine.

Dinner and overnight stay in Dambulla.

Day 07: Dambulla - Pinnawala - Beach Hotel



Breakfast at the hotel.

Transfer to a beach hotel via Pinnawala.

Visit the Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage, home to over 80 elephants.

Observe feeding and bathing times, and see baby elephants being bottle-fed.

Continue to your beach hotel from Waikkala to Kalutara.
